Owner responsibilities:

- Install any necessary erosion control (silt fence).
- Pump down pond level to bottom of existing wall.
- Remove existing trees and stumps.
- Apply Roundup to existing turf areas within work limits.
- Rototill all turf areas within work limits.
- Remove and dispose of existing cart path.
- Cut out new cart path and stockpile topsoil (by pump building).
- Install drainage and make irrigation repairs, as needed.
- Install cart path base and asphalt.

- Provide Rosetta wall stone.
- Prepare soil for grassing following topsoil replacement.
- Apply starter fertilizer.
- Install all sand, seed, sod and erosion matting, including haul roads.
