









We miss you! We miss seeing all of you at our community centers and enjoying all the programs and classes we traditionally offer.

HEParks is following closely with the Restore Illinois plan to reopen our State, planning to resume some operations once we transition into Phase 3 of the Reopen Plan under Governor Pritzker's revised Stay-at-Home Order. We are excited to provide our residents with both at-home virtual and in-person programming.

AT-HOME "VIRTUAL" PROGRAMS: These will occur from the comfort of your own home via Zoom calls, through access to youtube videos and more. Please read descriptions fully to understand the procedure for your particular class. Look for the "at-home" icon throughout the guide to indicate classes and programs that will take place in your own home.

THINGS TO NOTE WITH THESE NEW IN-PERSON PROGRAMS:

- Look for the "in-person" icon for classes and programs that will take place at an HEParks Facility.
- Payment is not required at the time of registration, however an up-to-date credit card and email must be on file for us to charge for the program.
- Payment for each program will be automatically charged to the payment method selected at the time registration on June 5.
- Class sizes will be maxed at 10 children to follow phase 3 group size requirements. Classrooms will be disinfected and cleaned before each class.
- Instructors will wear face coverings.
- Participants will wash hands upon arrival and wear face coverings when applicable.
- Only participants will be allowed in the building. Curbside drop-off will take place at the main entrance. Staff will meet students at vehicles and escort them to classes.
- If participant/staff members is showing symptoms of COVID, participant/staff will not enter the facility until CDC guidelines are met.
