

Triphahn Center Ice Arena Phase 3 Reopening Hockey Guidelines

All participants and coaches must abide by the following guidelines. Failure to abide by the guidelines may result in cancellation of program enrollment or program rental.

General Health

- Face coverings are required when entering the building.
- Six feet of physical distance must be maintained.
- Anyone entering the building must be free of any COVID-19 symptoms, including fever-free.

COVID-19 Exposure or Diagnosis

Participants or Coach who is exposed/diagnosed to COVID-19 may not return until:

- They have had no fever for 72 hours (without medicine)
AND
- Other symptoms have improved
AND
- At least 10 days have passed since their symptoms first appeared
OR
- Have had two negative COVID-19 tests in a row, with testing done at least 24 hours apart.

Cleaning

- Bathrooms will be cleaned every hour, including all high-touch areas.
- Locker rooms will be disinfected after each group use.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up

- Parent/guardians will not enter the facility (unless their younger player needs assistance with equipment.)
- Drop off & Pick up will take place in the circle drive at the Triphahn Center main entrance. Coaches will present at the circle drive.
- Players may not arrive earlier than 5 minutes from program start time.

Group Size

- Group sizes will be limited to 10 people per designated area.
- Groups will remain with the same group throughout the instruction/rental. Groups may not mix/switch participants.

Ice Use

- Only practices, drills and lesson activities may occur on the ice.
- No competitive games or contact play
- Activities will be setup to allow for 6-ft of distancing between participants.
- Participants must come to the rink dressed in hockey gear. Any personal items must be stored at least 6-ft away from others' belongings.
- It is recommended that players wear full-shield on helmet.
- Locker rooms will only be available to store personal belongings. Showering is not permitted.
- No handshakes at beginning or end of practice.
