Dog Training Area/Dog Park Waiver & Release

Important Information

You are solely responsible for supervising your dog and determining whether or not this is an appropriate activity to participate in. You must understand that you are participating in this activity at your own risk (and risk of your dog).

Dogs and permit holders of varying degrees of skill, training and experience use this facility.

You are solely responsible for determining if you and/or your dog are physically fit and/or adequately skilled to use this facility. It is always advisable, especially if you or your dog is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician or veterinarian before undertaking any dog training or exercise activity.

Warning of Risk

Dog exercise, walking, training leashed or simply allowing your dog off lead, is intended to provide a fun and rewarding experience for a dog and his owner/handler. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including death to either the dog or its owner. Dogs are pack animals and when "off lead", even the best-trained dogs will act instinctively. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include the propensity of any dog to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to another patron or dog. Other risks include, but are not limited to, the inexperience, negligence or irresponsibility of a dog owner; the inability to predict a dog's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or other animals; and actions by the dog due to fright, anger, stress, insect bites, or natural reactions such as jumping, pulling, resisting and biting. Other risks include the hazards associated with environmental and traffic conditions, acts of God, inclement weather, slip and falls, premises defects, equipment failure, failure in instruction/supervision, and all other circumstances inherent to dog and outdoor activities.

Should you attempt to break up a fight between dogs, you may be attacked and severely mauled by the other dog or attacked by the dog's owner/handler. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Hoffman Estates Park District, The City of Elgin or Streamwood Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

Waiver and Release of all Claims and Indemnification Agreement

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in consideration for permission to use this facility, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your dog might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with use of this facility and surrounding area.

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to the dog and its owner/handler in association with participating in dog activities, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that I might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of this facility and surrounding area.

I do hereby agree to waive, relinquish, release and forever discharge the Hoffman Estates Park District, The City of Elgin and Streamwood Park District including its officials, agents, volunteers and from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss that I may have or which may accrue to me and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this use of this facility and surrounding area.

I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the Hoffman Estates Park District, The City of Elgin and Streamwood Park District from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions, and expenses (including attorney fees), on account of personal injuries or death to any person or dog, or damages to property occurring, growing out of, incident to, or resulting directly or indirectly from my use of this facility and surrounding area.

I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning of risk, assumption of risk and waiver and release of all claims. If registering on-line or via fax, your on-line or facsimile signature shall substitute for and have the same legal effect as an original form signature.

Welcome to the Dog Park!



Membership

- This off leash area is to be used only by dogs with a Hoffman Estates Park District off leash park membership.
- To purchase a membership, dogs must have current vaccinations: Rabies, Distemper, Hepatitis, Para Influenza, Parvo Virus, Leptospirosis, Kennel Cough / Bordetella and negative fecal test. All dogs must also have valid dog license from the village or city corresponding to the dog owner's home address
- Membership is an annual membership. Membership fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Dog Behavior

- The dog owner agrees to assume the full risk of any injuries, damage or loss connected with or associated with the use of the dog park.
- If your dog injures another dog or handler, give your name and phone number to the injured party. Incidents can be reported to the police by calling 911 or by calling HEParks at 847-285-5440.
- Aggressive dogs must be removed from the park immediately. Excessive barking is strongly discouraged and may result in the temporary or permanent loss of park privileges.
- Cooperation between handlers is expected and required.

Keep the Park Clean

- Handlers must immediately pick up after their dog(s), and fill all holes their dog digs.
- Toys are permitted at your own risk. Please do not leave any toys at the park as they may harm other dogs or be destroyed/ thrown away during maintenance.
- Water is available (during summer) at the park. Please bring your own container. Do not leave containers at the park.

Park Visits

- Do not allow people or dogs in the park who do not have a key fob, even a not working key fob. Call HEParks at 847-285-5440 or 847-885-7500 to inquire why the fob is not working. Please report anyone entering without a fob to HEParks or call 911.
- Dogs must be leashed while entering and exiting the park. Leashes must be removed once in the park. Handlers must have leash in their possession at all times.
- A handler age 18 or older must be present at all times and is solely responsible for the actions of their dog(s).
- Children must be at least 6 years of age and accompanied by a parent/guardian 18 years or older to enter the dog park. Children must remain beside the parent/guardian at all times and may not play on dog park equipment.
- Only dogs under 25 pounds may use the "small dog" park side of each park.
- Dogs in heat (estrus) are not permitted in the park.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted in the park.
- No food for human consumption, or meals for dogs are allowed. Dog handlers may give dog treats only to their dog(s).
- No alcoholic beverages or glass containers permitted.
- Handlers are limited to two dogs per visit.
- Dogs not leashed outside of the dog park are subject to fines and loss of membership.

Infractions of any park rules will result in permanent revocation of a dog's membership and the privilege to use this park. Rules will be strictly enforced with zero tolerance.
